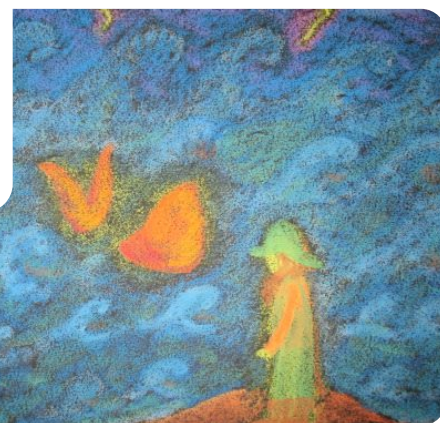

Grades Training Program



This is a part time program of 5 weeks each year for 4 years comprising of 3 weeks in July, 5 days in the fall, and 6 days in spring, annually. Throughout the four years, studies in Anthroposophy and Waldorf Education are interwoven with artistic and practical subjects. The emphasis will be on understanding all aspects of child development. The first year serves as an important orientation year in which students become familiar with the concepts and ideas that are part of the Anthroposophical approach to education, as well as covering the first two grades of the Waldorf curriculum.
