**Financial Information**

There is a C\$100 non-refundable application fee required with each application for admission.

In addition to tuition fees and the annual archive fee of \$10, the student can expect to pay approximately C\$100 for books per year, C\$150 for musical instruments (recorder & flute) C\$40 for art supplies and C\$12 for eurythmy shoes. A Housing Coordinator assists with finding accommodation for a training session at approximately \$30-\$35 per night or \$450-\$500 for 3 weeks. Catered meals are available. Housing, meals and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student. Students are advised to check if additional medical insurance is needed if travelling from outside British Columbia.

A tax deduction receipt to show payment of tuition fees will be provided for all Canadian students in accordance with Canada Revenue Agency guidelines.
