There is a \$100 non-refundable application fee required with each application for admission.

In addition to tuition fees and the annual archive fee of \$10, the student can expect to pay approximately C\$150 for books per year, and one-time purchases of C\$120 for silk, C\$100 - \$500 for a musical instrument (lyre), C\$30 for a special 'sun tone' tuning fork and C\$12 for eurythmy shoes. A Housing Coordinator assists with finding accommodation for a training session at \$30-\$35 per night. Catered meals are available. Accommodation, meals and travel expenses are the responsibility of the student. Students are advised to check if additional medical insurance is needed if travelling from outside of British Columbia, Canada.

A tax deduction receipt to show payment of tuition fees will be provided to all Canadian students in accordance with Canada Customs and Revenue Agency guidelines.
