Live online workshops

This workshop series is open to parents and others who wish to know more about Waldorf educational approaches to homeschooling and how to incorporate them into an at home program. We will focus on three age groupings of Early Childhood, Grades 1-8 and High School.

Early Childhood with Kim Hunter: Through the lens of early child development we will explore what to do when and why, with part of each class being devoted to practical suggestions (activities, the arts, movement, etc.) that you may want to include in homeschooling. We will consider ideals such as routine, rhythm, nutrition, sleep and technology and look at philosophical ideas around home-educating and education in general.

Grades with Diane Walters: Homeschooling tips and tricks for Grades 1-8 will be offered by Diane Walters. She will walk through the scope of the Waldorf curriculum using a program she calls the 'Curriculum Seal.' This is a multidisciplinary approach to both teaching and learning ideally suited to the home school environment.

High School with Barbarah Nicoll: Engaging with high school aged youth in self-directed learning can be a rich and fulfilling experience for the whole family. We will look at the questions that arise within adolescents from the ages of 14 to 18 and explore Waldorf curricular approaches that can support homeschooling during the upper grades.
