

Waldorf Grades Teacher Training

Next cohort begins summer, 2022



on Vancouver Island, British Columbia, Canada

This is a part time program of 5 weeks per year over 3 years, comprising 3 weeks in July and a week in November and February each successive year. If all in-class experience and fieldwork has been successfully completed, graduation is possible in February of the third year making the duration 2 years and 8 months.

Throughout the program, studies in Anthroposophy and Waldorf Education are interwoven with artistic and practical subjects. Emphasis will be on understanding all aspects of child development, the unfolding of the Grades 1 through 8 curriculums, and practical experiences in the classroom. Each year brings a deeper understanding of the concepts and ideas that are part of the anthroposophical approach to education and the observation and practicum aspects provide actual teaching experiences.

Entry to the program is possible every year.
