We are now accepting applications for the position of a Grades Teacher, including main lesson and skills for the 2022-2023 School Year.

The ideal candidate will have the following:

- Strong communication skills
- Ability to work as part of a team with the existing faculty group
- Strong commitment to Waldorf education
- Demonstrated ability to work with the parents to support and strengthen their understanding of Waldorf education
- Waldorf Teacher Education Certificate and/or Ontario Teacher training preferred

Our school offers professional development opportunities and mentoring for faculty. We have a working Board of Directors and a highly involved parent community. Edge Hill Country School is a non-profit organization.

This is a full-time, salaried position with tuition remission. Regular hours are Monday through Thursday from 8:30am - 3:30pm, with one 2 hour afternoon/evening faculty meeting each week. Yearly contracts range from \$22,000 to \$37,000 depending on education and experience.
