Dear WCI Students that will travel to Canada this summer,

WCI strongly recommends that all international students planning to travel to Canada fully understand the Government of Canada and BC Government laws and regulations before making travel plans. Please note that Government of Canada and BC Government restrictions and regulations are subject to change. Check the government websites for the most up-to-date information. (Government of Canada, Government of British Columbia)

## As of October 1st, 2022:

- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination is **not required**
- COVID-19 pre-entry and arrival tests are not required
- Quarantine after you enter Canada is **not required**
- Using <u>ArriveCAN</u> is **not required** 
  - if you're flying into Toronto Pearson, Vancouver, Winnipeg or Montréal-Trudeau international airports, you can still use ArriveCAN to complete your <u>Advance CBSA</u> <u>Declaration</u> to save time upon arrival
- Pre-boarding tests for cruise passengers are not required
- As always, <u>travel documents</u> are required
- Health checks to board planes and trains are not required
- Wearing masks on planes and trains is **not required**

## **Medical Insurance**

Those who are attending the Program from outside of Canada are strongly advised to make arrangements for medical insurance for the duration of the session/program while in Canada. This is the responsibility of the students.

## Housing

Visit the <u>Housing page</u> of our website for housing information. We are required by law to inform international students about <u>tenancy rights in BC</u>, though it will probably not be relevant due to the short-term nature of the training sessions.

## Meals
